

## Champagne/Sparkling & Rose Wines

### 1. Henriot "Blanc de Blancs" €110

is a luxurious and elegant champagne that's known for its intense and complex aroma and crisp, lively taste. The nose is full of floral notes with a touch of white fruit, creating a sophisticated and inviting aroma. On the palate, the champagne is fruity and crisp, with a lively effervescence that creates a refreshing and satisfying drinking experience.
